GLEE CLUB ACTIVITIES

At the March meeting of the PTC the Glee Club sang their contest numbers which were: Gianina Mia and Spirit Flower. At the preliminary music contest on April 15, which was held at Sutherland they received a division II rating.

On May 13, the Glee Club sang at the Baccalaureate Service. Their numbers were: Spanish Procession, in which Janet Hegna sang the soprano solo, and You'll Never Walk Alone.
